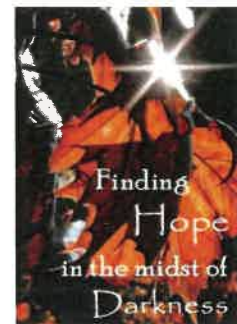
Restorative Justice & Healing

Last year, after the revelation of the abuse scandal in Pennsylvania and with Cardinal McCarrick, we had several listening sessions at Assumption. The sessions provided an opportunity to discuss, ask questions and vent a fair amount of frustration over the harm of the clergy abuse scandal and the coverup in our church. Since then, the Archdiocese has implemented programs addressed at healing the harm.

Next weekend, here at Assumption, you are invited to a morning of restorative justice in the biblical and theological context. The Archdiocese is hosting a session on Saturday, October 26th from 9:00am-Noon in the lower church. Presenters will be Janine Geske, former Wisconsin Supreme Court Justice and Marquette Law School professor; and Fr. Daniel Griffith, pastor at Our Lady of Lourdes and Liaison of Restorative Justice and Healing in the Archdiocese.

I recently attended one of these sessions and found it provided a positive approach to listening. It also showed a path, while being compassionate and understanding toward victims of sexual abuse, towards healing for us as individuals, as a parish and as a local church. 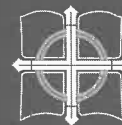
