## Holy Week Begins

We celebrate this Holy Week and look forward to sharing these meaningful services with you.

#### Palm Sunday, April 2

(Mass recorded and available online).

Today we proclaim Jesus' glorious entrance into Jerusalem. As the Passion is read at the Gospel, the journey moves from rejoicing to the harsh reality of Jesus' complete self-gift through his suffering and death on the Cross.

#### Holy Thursday, April 6

#### The Lord's Supper, 6:00pm

Jesus models his commandment to love one another by washing his disciples' feet. We also hear the Words of Institution at the Last Supper – those words which first revealed Christ's presence in the Eucharist.

Good Friday, April 7 (A day of fast and abstinence).

#### The Lord's Passion, 12:00 Noon

(Service will be livestreamed and recorded).

Christ's sacrifice on the cross is the focal point. We witness Jesus' capture and crucifixion from the Gospel of John. At the end of this liturgy, we leave the church in silence, waiting to celebrate the glory of our Lord's resurrection.

#### Stations of the Cross, 3:00pm

#### Tenebrae (Service of Darkness), 8:00pm

Tenebrae captures the mourning that occurred following Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem through his crucifixion. Throughout the service candles are extinguished to represent the sorrow felt by Jesus, his disciples and his followers.


