School Work to Begin

After months of planning and working with the city, interior demolition work on the historic school building is set to begin this Monday, April 10. One



of the first changes will be the removal and boarding up of the windows. The old windows need to be removed so accurate measurements can be taken for the new replacement windows.

When the weather improves, tuckpointing will begin as well as excavation work for the addition. The school restoration project was made possible by the generosity of parishioners and friends through our recent *A Campus Connecting Generations* capital campaign. 


