Venezuelan Mission Appeal

In 1970, the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis established a partnership with the parish of Jesucristo Resucitado, located in Ciudad Guayana, Venezuela. Archdiocesan priests have



been assigned as pastors who, along with a committed team, are caring for an estimated 65,000 people who live in the 11 distinct barrios or neighborhoods within the parish. This weekend, Fr. Greg Shaffer, the current pastor will be here to speak about the needs of the poor and needy within the parish and how we can generously offer our prayers and gifts of support.

Venezuela has been in economic and political crisis for years. At the parish, however, the crisis is measured less by economic statistics than it is by the pastoral realities: families going hungry, elderly parishioners abandoned by adult children who can no longer care for them, and young men killed in escalating gang violence. A vast majority suffer from unemployment with lack of healthcare and basic nutrition. Contribution envelopes are in the pews. Donations can also be made via the parish website (assumptionsp.org).
