Dear Parishioners & Friends -

It was one year ago when, after two months of no congregation, we were able to open our doors for a limited public Mass. Now with the success of the vaccines and progress on the pandemic, we are ready to join others in the state and open the doors even wider, remove the ropes and restore many of our regular practices at Mass.



With the Governor's recent announcement, we are no longer limited in regard to social distancing requirements **effective May 28, 2021**. We are, however, still bound by the City of St. Paul's mandate regarding the continued wearing of masks indoors. Beginning next weekend, May 29-30:

- Social distancing mandates expire and unrestricted seating returns to Assumption.
- Masses will be broadcast in the lower church for those who would like more space. There will not be a separate Mass in the lower church.
- We will resume taking up a collection during the offertory. Offerings can still be placed in the collection boxes, which will remain in place.
- Distribution of Communion returns to during Mass with stations in the front and in the back on weekends.
- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass continues.
- The virtual Mass will continue.
- Confessions will return to the sacristy on Tuesday, June 1. Daily confessions will be heard from 11:15-11:45am (please note the time change). Confessions are at 4:00pm on Saturdays.

We look forward to a full return of all the practices we enjoyed before the pandemic. In the upcoming weeks and months, we will look forward to the return of: missalettes, coffee and donuts, the choir, the resumption of the various ministry groups and some social events. Stay tuned for more information.

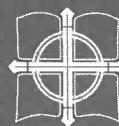
