This weekend Assumption is holding a collection drive for Second Stork, a St. Paul-based, non-profit that helps new parents in need. Second Stork works through hospital staff to distribute essential items to the family as they prepare to leave the hospital. Needed items include new one piece sleepers (preemie, newborn and 0-3 months sizes) and lightweight (cotton or flannel) receiving blankets. All donated items must be new.


