Dear Friends at Assumption,

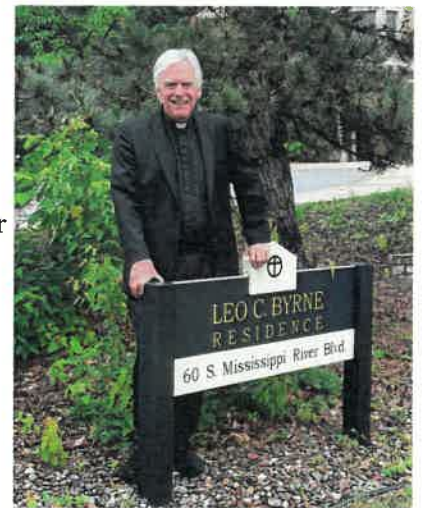
I want to thank Father Treacy for letting me take his space in the parish bulletin to write about the Archbishop Leo C. Byrne Residence Retirement Residence for Priests in the Archdiocese of St. Paul-Minneapolis. The residence is scheduled to undergo major renovation at a cost of \$6.5 million dollars. Hence the reason to reach out to you and other parishioners throughout the Archdiocese and ask for help in reaching our goal.

Frankly, I am a little sheepish writing this article, especially right after all of you have heard about some vital needs here at

Assumption. I also know most people are not presently experiencing the best of economic times. However, I have always operated with the philosophy of "how do you know unless you ask." Throughout my years as pastor, I have always trusted that those I have asked, for the various needs of parish and for the Archdiocese, will respond as each parishioner or person sees fit. At the end of the day, it has always been enough.

The Leo. C. Byrne Residence is located on the St. Paul Seminary Campus on the corner of Summit Avenue and Mississippi River Blvd. It is an independent living facility which can house 29 retired priests. Each priest has an apartment. Both myself and Father Jack Long are residents.

Over the years and for a variety of reasons, the residence, which is owned and operated by the Archdiocese, has fallen into disrepair. The deferred maintenance and care of the building has come to the point where major renovation is needed for the long term well being of the physical space as well as the priests who live there.
