Volunteering for Habitat Twin Cities is fun. No construction experience is required and no one is asked to do anything that they are not comfortable with. All tools, equipment and supplies are provided. You may sign up for any or all of the five day experience. Adult volunteers and youth age 16 and older are eligible to work at construction sites. Volunteer youth age 14 and older are eligible and welcome to work at the Habitat Restore.


