City Water Project

Saint Paul Regional Water Services has begun work in the neighborhood to replace the water main along the north side of 9th Street. The work will directly impact the parish as the water main runs under the garage on the west side of the campus. Street parking will be restricted at times to allow space for construction equipment. We will keep you updated with any significant changes. The work is scheduled to be completed in four weeks.

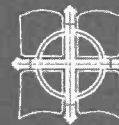
