Music will be by GHBB, a local St. Paul band. The band, which plays classic rock and blues, has played at various venues, including the state fair. Reservations are not required. Feast of the Assumption

Next weekend (August 20-21), we will celebrate our patronal feast, the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The parish choir will be singing at the 9:30am mass on Sunday. The feast is not a holy day of obligation this year because August 15 falls on a Monday.

We will also resume *coffee and donuts* after all the Masses on August 21. Weather permitting, we will gather outside under the tents. If rain is forecasted coffee and donuts will be in the lower church. All are welcome.

Assumption is a very old feast of the church, celebrated universally by the sixth century. Because it signifies the Blessed Virgin's passing into eternal life, it is the most important of all Marian feasts. This special day is also known as the Feast of the Dormition, a word which means "the falling asleep."

On the Feast of the Assumption in 1855, the cornerstone of the first Assumption church was laid. The roof was completed the following year and the first service was held on May 25, 1856. We are grateful to those German immigrants who founded Assumption over 165 years ago.
