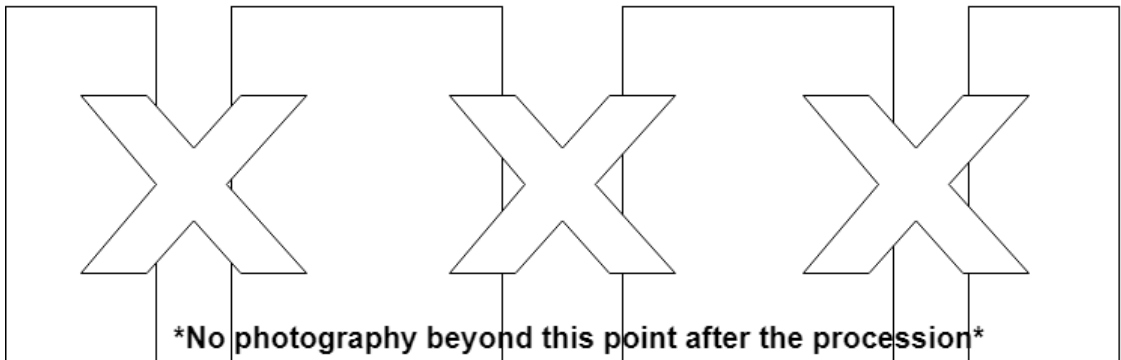
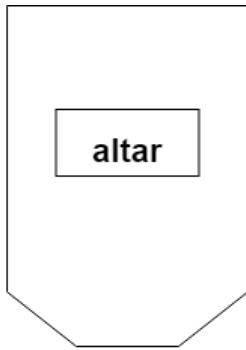
Photography and Videography Policy

Photos may be taken before and/or after the wedding ceremony. You may schedule photos for an hour-and-a-half to two-hour session, making sure you finish 30 minutes before the ceremony start time. If pictures are taken inside the church after the ceremony on Saturdays, keep in mind that everything needs to be completed by 3:45 p.m. to have the church available for Confessions.

Designated photographers and videographers (professional or amateur) are expected to remain inconspicuous and to respect the sacred dignity of the church and ceremony at all times.

The following rules determine where and when photographers and videographers may shoot during the ceremony:

- Photographers may use the center aisle during the procession and recession
- Otherwise, photographers may use the center aisle if situated several pews behind guests
- Photographers may shoot in the area between the east and west doors but may proceed no closer to the altar from that area
- Photographers and videographers are encouraged to situate themselves near the columns so as not to obscure the views of guests
- No flash photography is allowed during the ceremony, including the procession and recession
- Guests are prohibited from using phones or cameras to record the service
