

Feast of the Assumption

On Tuesday, August 15th we will celebrate our patronal feast, The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Masses will be Monday, August 14 at 5:15pm and Tuesday, August 15 at 7:00am, 12:00pm and 5:15pm. The Assumption choir will sing at the 5:15pm Mass. This is a holy day of obligation. (Please note there will be no confessions on August 15th.)



On the Feast of the Assumption in 1855, the cornerstone of the first Assumption church was laid. The roof was completed the following year and the first service was held on May 25, 1856. We are grateful to those German immigrants who founded Assumption over 165 years ago.


