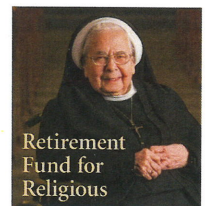
## *Catholic Services Appeal*

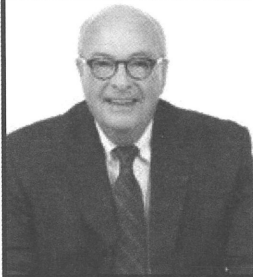

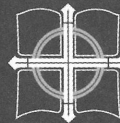
