#### East Parking Lot Update:



Several years ago, Assumption purchased the property located to the east of the church, which included a pay parking lot and a vacant building. Our plan was to demolish the building and provide a whole new lot that would maximize parking while

meeting green space, water management requirements and continue the tradition of providing a beautiful campus.

Over the last year we have worked with architects and landscape designers to develop plans that best fits the needs of Assumption. The plan includes additional parking, a handicap drop-off area, improved lighting and security, additional green spaces and new signage. We continue to work through some final details with the hope of submitting the plan to the City of St. Paul in the next few weeks.

Once the city approves the plan, we will provide more information and a look at the final renderings. At this time, we are optimistic that work will begin in June and be completed by early August. Once completed, parishioners and guests will have an improved experience coming to Assumption with a greater sense of welcome, community and safety.

#### Venezuelan Mission Appeal

In 1970, the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis established a partnership with the parish of Jesucristo

Resucitado, located in Ciudad Guayana, Venezuela. Archdiocesan priests have been assigned as pastors who, along with a committed team, are caring for an estimated 65,000 people who live in the 11 distinct barrios or neighborhoods within the parish. This weekend, Fr. Greg Shaffer, the current pastor will be here to speak about the needs of the poor and needy within the parish and how we can generously offer our prayers and gifts of support.


